

NRYB Coaching Responsibilities

The N.R.Y.B. Board of Directors appreciates your volunteering in our program. The following information should help you perform your duties and responsibilities.

1. When your game is the first one of the day, say 12:00PM, the gym will not open before 12:00PM in most cases. Tell your players not to arrive at 11:30AM.
2. Coaches in the 3/4 grade are responsible for putting the baskets up at 10:30AM and taking them down after the last game. Do not be afraid to ask parents/spectators for help.
3. All coaches should communicate with the referee to ensure clear lines of communication.
4. Be on time for practice. Do not allow your players to roam the school or town buildings. Trips to the bathroom and water cooler should be short. One player at a time is recommended.
5. Equipment at the middle school is stored in the storage room, custodians will unlock the door.
6. Equipment should be returned to storage after games.
7. Do not give your players a chance to lose focus by keeping your practices interesting. We have a number of Board members who have coached for many years and will help any coach if asked. We also have videos available that can increase your knowledge of the game and help you to run good practices.
8. If you experience a problem with a parent or player let us know as soon as possible.
9. Coaches should be certain that their team areas are cleaned of water bottles, etc. after games and practices.
10. Please do not hesitate to remind parents that you are there to coach, not baby-sit. If you have a problem with unsupervised children, please inform a board member.
